

4th Grade Classroom Expectations *~ so that everyone can succeed!*

Stay in your seat so you don't distract others; raise your hand for permission to do something outside of your desk.

Be respectful to the teacher by not talking unless called upon.

Be respectful to your classmates with your words and actions.

Use planned times at break and recesses for bathroom and drink needs whenever possible.

We have a lot to learn in a short amount of time; stay focused on one task at a time.

Do your work as neat as possible and to the best of your ability.

Ask the teacher for help when you are confused or don't understand.

Verbal warnings are a "warning" to change behavior.

If behavior continues to be disruptive or disrespectful, a child's name on the board indicates a loss of 5 minutes of recess.

A third offense in the day warrants a full loss of recess, with a "reflection report" filled out by the child, and signed by both parent & teacher.

Come to school each day prepared and with a positive attitude! Leave each afternoon prepared and with a positive attitude, too!
