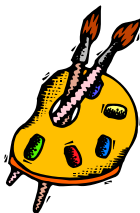

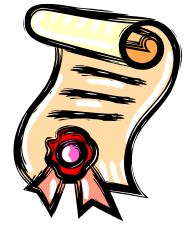
PURPOSE & PLANNING
